**Theme: “Honoring Our People”**

#### Photography Contest Rules:

1. Two age groups: Adults (ages 19 and over) and Youth (ages 18 and under) may enter.
2. The Theme for this year’s contest is “Honoring Our People”. May enter up to 2 categories (ex: Military, Law Enforcement, Education, Athletics, Arts & Entertainment, Health Care & etc.
3. Photos must be in color.
4. Prints must be a minimum of 5X7 inches, but no larger than 18X18 inches.
5. You may use film or digital camera.
6. Photos should be mounted flat on plain white or black poster board or foam board. Mounted size may be no larger than 20X20.
7. Please include the following on the back of your mounted photo: Name, Address, phone number  
Photography category (adult 19 and over or youth 18 and under).
8. Do not include titles or other information on the front of mounted board
9. Entries will be received at the Red Bay City Hall on Thursday, September 13, 2018 between the hours of 8:30 A.M.—4:00 P.M.
10. Photos must have been taken by contestant submitting the entry.
11. Photos in each category will be judged for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
12. Winners in each category will be awarded a cash prize and ribbon as follows: 1st place: \$50.00, 2nd place: \$30.00, and 3rd place: \$ 20.00.
13. Best in Show will receive a Plaque

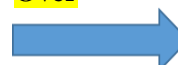
#### Fried Pie Contest Rules:

## 9TH ANNUAL FOUNDERS DAY QUILTING CONTEST

Quilts may be **delivered** on Thursday, September 13, 2018 to Red Bay City Hall from 8:30 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Quilts will be **judged** Saturday, September 15, 2018 and will be on display during the Founders Day Festival at Red Bay City Hall located at 203 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue; SE; Red Bay, Alabama. Winners will be announced during the Festival and winners' photos will be featured in the Franklin County Times, Franklin Free Press and Red Bay News.

### Quilt Contest Rules:

- All quilt entries must be clean, free of odor and pet hair; constructed of fabric (three layers—top, batting and backing) and unframed or stretched on another material.
- All quilt entries must have a label attached to the back. The label must include at least the name of the maker(s), address, telephone number, age category, and the year completed.
- Quilts to be judged must be constructed and quilted by the person(s) named on the entry form only. There is no age restriction for judged entries. All quilts must be quilted by either hand or machine. No tied quilts or comforters will be accepted.
- There are two (2) age groups:
  1. Adult (ages 19 and over)
  2. Youth (ages 18 and under)

### Exhibition Categories:

- **Pieced** – piecing predominates over other techniques in amount and effect.
  - Hand Quilted
  - Machine Quilted
- **Appliqué** – Appliqué predominates in amount or effect.
  - Hand Quilted
  - Machine Quilted
  - Hand and machine-Both hand and machine technique are both used to develop the design of the quilt top.
- **Mixed/Other** – Both piecing and appliqué used to develop design of the quilt top OR quilt is constructed using one special technique such as embroidery, whole cloth, embellishment or other surface design.
  - Hand Quilted
  - Machine Quilted

#### **\*Quilting Techniques:**

Hand Quilted – Entry is entirely quilted by hand.

Machine Quilted – Entry is entirely quilted by machine.

Hand and Machine Quilted- Entry contains both machine and hand quilting.

### Awards:

#### **Hand Quilted:**

- Pieced, Appliquéd, Mixed/Other
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place = \$60.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> Place = \$40.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> Place = \$20.00

#### **Machine Quilted:**

- Pieced, Appliquéd, Mixed/Other
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place = \$60.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> Place = \$40.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> Place = \$20.00

#### **Hand and Machine Quilted**

- Pieced, appliqued, mixed
- Other
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place-\$60.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> Place-\$40.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> Place-\$20.00

Best in Show = \$50.00 & Plaque



### Quilt Pick-Up:

✓Quilts will be displayed at City Hall; 203 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, Red Bay, AL. All entries must remain on display for the duration of the quilt show. Although every precaution will be taken to protect your entry, neither the City of Red Bay nor the Franklin County Extension Office will be responsible for any damage or loss.

Quilts may be picked up on Tuesday, September 18, 2018 from the Red Bay City Hall between the hours of 8:30 A.M.—3:00 P.M.
