WHEREAS, the 2019 Alabama Legislature has passed bill HB2 to levy additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel, and


WHEREAS, the City of Red Bay is to receive a portion of said tax and


WHEREAS, the City of Red Bay will adopt an annual transportation plan no later than August 31 of the next fiscal year based on estimated revenues
