WHEREAS, the 2019 Alabama Legislature passed Bill HB2 to levy additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Red Bay began receiving its share of distribution of said taxes January 2020; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Red Bay retains said tax funds in a separate fund account and expends the funds exclusively for the maintenance, repair, replacement and construction of roads located within the city limits of Red Bay as mandated by Bill HB2; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Red Bay will adopt an annual transportation plan no later than August 31 of the next fiscal year based on estimated revenues;




