

NOTICE FROM THE CITY OF RED BAY SANITATION DEPARTMENT

THE CITY OF RED BAY SANITATION DEPARTMENT WILL BE IMPLEMENTING A NEW AUTOMATED GARBAGE TRUCK SYSTEM THE WEEK OF **MAY 15TH THROUGH MAY 19TH** . DURING THIS WEEK, THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT WILL BE DELIVERING ONE (1) FREE, NEW GARBAGE CAN TO EACH RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE CUSTOMER AND ONE (1) FREE CAN TO EACH BUSINESS OR INDUSTRY. AFTER THE WEEK OF **MAY 15TH THROUGH MAY 19TH**, ONLY THE CITY ISSUED CANS WILL BE USED FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION; THEREFORE, ALL PREVIOUSLY USED METHODS OF GARBAGE COLLECTION WILL NO LONGER BE USED INCLUDING CANS, DUMPSTERS, BARRELS, ETC. ALL RESIDENTIAL DUMPSTER-TYPE GARBAGE BINS **MUST** BE PERMANENTLY REMOVED FROM RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY. THE CITY OF RED BAY SANITATION DEPARTMENT WILL REMOVE CLEAN, EMPTY RESIDENTIAL DUMPSTER-TYPE GARBAGE BINS FREE OF CHARGE THE WEEK OF **MAY 15TH THROUGH MAY 19TH**. THE NEW, FREE CAN AND ADDITIONAL CANS, IF NEEDED, ARE THE PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF RED BAY AND WILL BE ASSIGNED TO EACH RESIDENCE, BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY.

THE CITY OF RED BAY MUST IMPLEMENT THIS NEW, AUTOMATED SYSTEM DUE TO THE NEED OF REPLACING OLD, OUT-DATED, OBSOLETE GARBAGE TRUCKS WITH NEW AUTOMATED TECHNOLOGY. THE CAN REQUIREMENTS WILL ESTABLISH A CLEANER, FASTER, SAFER METHOD OF GARBAGE COLLECTION WHILE ALSO ENHANCING BEAUTIFICATION IN THE ENTIRE CITY OF RED BAY.

NEW GARBAGE CAN GUIDELINES

- All garbage should be in plastic bags placed in the issued City of Red Bay can to keep the can clean and prevent it from littering garbage when emptied.
- Do not overload the can or place items on top of can. The lid should be closed, avoid overflowing.
- **NO EXTRA BAGS, BOXES, OR EXCESS GARBAGE THAT IS PLACED ON OR AROUND CANS WILL BE PICKED UP. ONLY GARBAGE PLACED IN THE CAN WILL BE PICKED UP.**
- Can(s) must be no further than 3 to 4 feet from roadside.
- Can **HANDLE AND WHEELS** should face your house. The lid opening toward the street.
- Position cans at least five (5) feet away from any other objects such as mailbox, trees, poles, fence, vehicle, basketball goal, etc.
- Do Not block cans or curbside access with parked car(s).
- Do Not place cans under wires or low tree branches.
- Do Not Obstruct lid openings with ties, cords, chains, etc.
- Should you need an additional can, contact Red Bay City Hall at 256-356-4473 ext. 3 (\$11.50 monthly charge per additional can).
